_____ R-Vowel Level (At least 5 to10% of the words contain R vowels. At least 80% of the words contain long, short, other, or *r* vowels or are familiar high-frequency words.)

Other Vowel Level (At least 5 to 10% of the words contain other vowels. At least 80% of the words contain short, long, r-vowels, or other vowels or are familiar high-frequency words)
